### **GUIDANCE this month:**

The conversation continues around being mindful. Students enjoyed the book, *How Do Dinosaurs Eat Their Food* by Jolen Yolen. Students were able to identify behaviour that is mindful or unmindful and decide which part of the brain is in charge. Thinking mindfully happens when our brain has time to think about what we hear or see before we respond to it. Students discussed our five senses and focused in on mindful listening. When we carefully listen, we can hear things that we don't usually hear when we are busy working in our classrooms. The RAS (Reticular Activating System) works to allow the important sights, sounds, tastes, feelings, and smells pass onto the brain and blocks unwanted information. We demonstrated using a kitchen strainer and how only the important things pass through the RAS. We can practice being mindful and help our RAS to be more effective. *Denise Kelly, Guidance Teacher*
