Pattern/Texture

Texture refers to the surface quality in a work of art. Texture can suggest emotions by linking with the memory of how things feel.

Cross hatching is one way that we can give the idea of texture.

There are three keys to creating texture with cross hatching:

- The weight (darkness or lightness of the lines)
- The lead type in the Pencil
