

Student Led Clubs



Steps to Starting a Club:

- 4. Fill out Club Application Form and submit it to Mrs. O'Leary for approval.

Student Leader

- Provide materials (bring Lego, etc)

- Be in attendance
- Be a positive leader (not too bossy)
- Organize clean up and storage
- Set and teach expectations/ norms/rules
