First Day of School!

The first day of school is always exciting and busy!

Safety of students is our priority and we appreciate your help and support on this busy day as students are finding their way. As you can imagine, our sidewalks and parking lot will be full - please pay attention to areas where no parking is permitted, watch for pedestrians and follow the rules of the 'Kiss and Drop' to keep things running smoothly.

Families of kindergarten students should have been contacted already with information about whether their first day is Tuesday or Wednesday. Those children and their parents/guardians will begin their day at 9 o'clock in the cafetorium where they will be met by their teachers to take them to classrooms. When they return for day two, they will use the lobby door.

Students in grades 1 and 2 who walk to school or are dropped off will enter through the lobby doors. Teachers will be on duty to greet them and help them into the building, while other staff will be inside to make sure they find their way to the right class.

Intermediate students (grades 3, 4 and 5) will enter the building through the "Kiss and Drop" door in the morning and will also be greeted by duty teachers who can provide any directions they may require. 
