Our words of the week:



Due to the short week this week, we will be reviewing previously taught words. Please continue to practice these words at home.

Literacy: This week we will introduce prepositions to students, review 'i before e, except after c' and complete a book talk on 3 different books from our school Book Fair to grow an excitement for reading.

Writing: We have set our writing goals and are working on including these in our daily writing. We are beginning our unit on letter writing and students will be writing for authentic reasons to different students/teachers throughout the school.

Math: We have completed our first week of multiplication and the students are really enjoying making groups with equal amounts as well as arrays to find their multiplication sentence and repeated addition sentence. Please use the green sheet sent home last Thursday to practice the math facts at home.

Remember when making arrays and equal groups, that first number is your group number and the second number is how many objects.

Ex: 2 groups of 3 - $2 \times 3 = 6$ - $3 + 3 = 6$
