Math:

This week we will be learning how to subtract with borrowing and will continue to review addition with re-grouping. We are constantly reviewing front-end addition, using number lines and hundred charts as different strategies when adding or subtraction 2- digit numbers.

We will be going into 3-digit numbers after March Break. Please make sure your child is practicing all ways taught in class throughout the week at home.

Homework will be coming home this week for practicing addition and subtraction with regrouping and borrowing. Please make sure this is returned by Friday, February 3rd. Please make sure students are using IXL throughout the week to practice previous outcomes taught in class.

Literacy: This week we will review pronouns, different fonts in writing, and showing possession in plural and singular nouns.
