Key Concepts

1. The prefix in- can mean "not."

indecisive inaccurate

2. *In-* becomes *il-* when added to a word root with *l.*

illegal

3. *In-* becomes *ir-* when added to a word root beginning with *r*.

4. *In-* becomes *im-* when added to a word root beginning with *m*, *b*, or *p*.
