Natural Disasters

1. geology – study of the Earth’s layers of soil and rocks
2. debris – pieces of something that has been broken or destroyed
3. evacuated – moved away from an area because it is dangerous there
4. glaciers – slow-moving masses of ice formed by snow that does not melt over many years
5. condemned – declared to be unsafe
6. incline – slanted slope or surface
7. liquefy – to make a solid into a liquid
8. eroded – worn away gradually by water or wind
9. topography – physical features of an area, including hills, valleys, mountains, plains and rivers
10. diameter – the length of the line passing through the center of a circular object
