Key Concepts

Long vowel sounds are often spelled with vowel combinations.

- The \a\ sound can be spelled *ai*, *ay*, or *a_e*.

stain playful grape

- The \e\ sound can be spelled *ea*, *ee*, *y*, *i_e*, or *e_e*.

reach seek handy machine compete

- The \i\ sound can be spelled *igh*, *y*, or *i_e*.

sigh sky prize

- The \o\ sound can be spelled *oa*, *ow*, *ough*, or *o_e*.

road blow dough close

- The \u\ sound can be spelled *ou*, *ew*, *eu*, *u*, *ue*, or *u_e*.
