wield conscience reign counterfeit deceit

Key Concepts

1. Remember this rhyme to help you spell many words with the *ie* and *ei* combinations.

Write i before e (shield relief)
except after c , (receipt ceiling)
or when sounded as a ,
as in neighbor and weigh.

2. Memorize these exceptions:

*conscience *leisure seize
either neither weird
forfeit foreign
