What we have Been Learning About

Curriculum Outcomes covered this month include:

Word families: -ide

Sight Words: so, who, would, very, two, than, no, me, look

Phonics: Bossy R (-er, -ir,-ur), silent e on the end of words

<u>Writing:</u> Our focus this month was letter writing. Students wrote letters to Santa, Mrs. Claus, friends and family. They did well with this unit. In January we will focus on personal narratives.

<u>Math:</u> In December we worked on addition to 12. Students worked on using different strategies, number lines, ten frames, and pictures, to help them solve addition problems. Students were introduced to word problems. This month we will focus on subtraction up to 12.

You and Your World: Our focus for You and Your World was the difference between wants and needs. We also talked about how advertisements influence our decisions.
