Anglophone West School District (ASD-W) public schools with Sitansisk-St. Mary's First Nation students, leadership from Sitansisk-St. Mary's First Nation (including the band operated school, Chief Harold Sappier Memorial Elementary School), and ASD-W Staff generate ideas on how to enhance education for Sitansisk-St. Mary's First Nation students.
