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Proposal Process

Perth-Andover area district schools with Tobique (Neqotkuk) First Nation students, Neqotkuk leadership (including band operated school Mahsos Elementary School), and ASD-W Staff generate ideas on how to enhance education for Neqotkuk First Nation students. These ideas are formalized as Enhancement proposals and are submitted to the Enhancement Committee for review and discussion at an Enhancement Committee meeting. The Enhancement Committee approves ideas when the proposal meets the criteria of the Enhancement Agreement, proposals match educational goals from the Strategic Education Plan and, when adequate funding is available. Enhancement proposal/project leaders are required to submit a final report to the Enhancement Committee upon completion of the project.
