English Prime Program

All students K-3 participate in French Language and culture learning experiences for 30 minutes weekly. Schools may choose to use the FLORA program materials to meet these minutes.

Grades 4-10 students participate in Pre-Intensive (Grade 4; 150 minutes per week), Intensive (Grade 5; one term 1000 minutes per week, and second term 150 minutes per week), and Post-Intensive French (Grades 6-10; grades 6-8; 200 minutes per week, and grades 9-10 one course per year).

At grade 4, FLORA program materials may be used to meet the Pre-Intensive French minutes.

Grades 11-12 students have optional courses, including on-line options available to them.

All schools in ASD- W offer the English Prime Program.



FRENCH LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES FOR RURAL AREAS (FLORA)

The Department of Education and Early Childhood Development introduced a new opportunity for K–3 elementary school children to learn French in rural areas. This program is for the early grades in rural schools with no access to French Immersion. Year 1 of the pilot was 2017-18 at one elementary school in ASDW.

In March 2020, as a response to the learning plan, FLORA was shared worldwide through the GNB website. In September 2020, FLORA was made available to all elementary schools and modules were made available to all English Prime teachers. Additional resources have been shared with schools to support the expansion of the program.

As a result of the program being made available to all elementary schools, the parameters in place for 2020-2021 are as follows for those schools that are working with FLORA.

- As part of the exploration block in K-2
- As part of the cross curricular block in Grade 3
- As part of the Pre-Intensive French Program or as a replacement to the Pre-Intensive Program in Grade 4
- As an enhancement to Intensive French in Grade 5

This program introduces children to their second official language in a new way. Supported by a teacher, students learn French through fun digital modules.

The modules are accessible to parents through their personal computer or a tablet borrowed from school so that they and their child can read, sing and play along. The main characters, Rigolo and Rigolette, engage children as they learn French. The activities are designed to reinforce literacy and numeracy skills that children are learning in English in their daily program. Rigolo and Rigolette provide practice in another context and this will stretch their imagination and deepen their learning.

The prototype projects will be assessed following the current school year, helping to shape future French second-language learning opportunities in the province.
