Bursary Guidelines

One page Application should include:

- Contact Information
- Student participation in High School
- School/Extra Curricular Activities
- Post-Secondary Plans
- Two references; one teacher and one non-related adult who has known the student for a minimum of two years.

Applicants must plan to attend a University, College, Technical School or other recognized post-secondary educational institute. Proof of acceptance will be required.

This bursary will award one student at both Leo Hayes and FHS, either male or female a \$ 1000.00 non-renewable bursary to go towards Post-secondary education.

Bursary Guidelines

To go to an athlete of any sport who is good in their sport but not necessarily the best in their sport.

To go to a student who has the marks to be accepted into any post-secondary program of their choice.
