

<u>In-House Scholarships</u>		Students must submit an ACTIVITY RESUME and complete an IN-HOUSE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM (available in Guidance). In addition, certain scholarships require an essay to be submitted. To be eligible, students must be taking a full course load and be writing exams.	
May 24, 2019	\$500 & plaque	<u>Ben Collins Memorial Award</u>	For a deserving male student athlete in need, (preference given to student who played football) who plans on continuing his education in the fall. Essay required (200 words or less) describing need and/or reasons for deserving the award.
May 24, 2019	\$240	<u>Ben and Faye Medjucks Prize</u>	For a deserving student with high average who demonstrates financial need.
May 24, 2019	\$200	<u>Brian Goodine Memorial</u>	For a deserving student who demonstrates leadership and high academic achievement.
May 24, 2019	\$1000	<u>Carl Brown Memorial</u>	Recognizes achievement in English. Financial need assessed.
May 24, 2019	\$100	<u>Celestial Chapter No. 3, Order of the Eastern Star</u>	Awarded to a graduating student who is not receiving any other prize, and who exemplifies the principles of our Order, which are Charity, Truth, and Loving Kindness.
May 24, 2019	(2) \$500	<u>Colter Family Award</u>	Awarded to one male and one female student with above average academics and leadership in extra-curricular activities.
May 24, 2019	\$400	<u>Mr. Donald MacKinnon Prize</u>	Awarded to a strong Math or Science graduate who has demonstrated ability in athletics or the arts.
May 24, 2019	\$500	<u>Doris E. Sullivan Scholarship</u>	Will be awarded to a deserving student of good academic standing who exemplifies the principles of I.O.D.E. - service, volunteering and community-mindedness - pursuing a post-secondary program of at least one full year.

May 24, 2019	(2) \$60	<u>Mr. and Mrs. Douglas S. Biggs Bursary</u>	Awarded to 1 male and 1 female student attending UNB.
May 24, 2019	\$100	<u>Emily Culberson Memorial Award</u>	To a graduating student who has been involved in the promotion of fairness and equality among students; preference will be given to a student who is an active participant of PAC.
May 24, 2019	(2) \$750	<u>Epsilon Y's Men's Club Scholarship</u>	Must have high academic record and school/community involvement; attending a Maritime post-secondary program. Financial need must be demonstrated; will not be awarded to someone receiving a major university entrance scholarship. Application should include a report of school and community service.
May 24, 2019	\$500	<u>Frank Greydanus Memorial</u>	Student planning to attend NBCC for Electrical, Plumbing, Carpentry or other apprenticeship trade. (Preference will be given to students in electrical trade however other trade courses and/or Co-op at FHS will be considered.)
May 24, 2019	(2) \$800	<u>Fredericton Golden Club</u>	Awarded to a student attending NBCC, or a recognized business college or trade school. Proof of registration is required. Based on academic performance, student's contribution to school and community activities and financial need .
May 24, 2019	\$500	<u>Kinsmen Club of Fredericton</u>	Awarded to a civic minded student attending university, community college or a technical institution. Selection is based on community service/involvement. Student must not be receiving any other prize.
May 24, 2019	\$100	<u>Maurice David Adilman Trust</u>	For a deserving student who has overcome adversity to excel and will be continuing their studies beyond high school.
May 24, 2019	\$1000	<u>Mike Fitzgerald Scholarship</u>	For a deserving grade 12 student, planning to attend post-secondary. Must demonstrate financial need .

May 24, 2019	\$1000	<u>NBCC Scholarship</u> (NB Public Colleges Entrance Scholarship)	To a graduate pursuing post-secondary studies at NBCC, CCNB, or NBCCD.
May 24, 2019	\$500	<u>NBTA Branch 1826</u>	Awarded to a graduating student pursuing post-secondary studies whose parent is a member of Branch 1826.
May 24, 2019	\$500	<u>Nobility Clothing Designs</u>	This award goes to a student studying in the area of fine arts. Priority will be given to those studying visual arts and crafts but all fine arts areas will be considered. Financial need will be taken into consideration.
May 24, 2019	\$450	<u>Orange Lodge</u>	For a strong student planning to study history at post-secondary.
May 24, 2019	\$2000	<u>Robert J. Howard</u>	The applicant must demonstrate leadership, integrity, good work ethic, scholastic ability, extracurricular involvement in the community, and involvement in charitable activities. The applicant must also submit a 500 word essay explain his/her academic achievements, school and community involvement, education and career plans. Financial need information required.

May 24, 2019	\$250	<u>UNB Faculty of Education</u>	For the grade 12 Peer Mentor who has shown to be a true role model for the students he/she has worked with this year. To be awarded to a student planning to attend UNB Fredericton.
