Becca Schofield, 18, of Riverview, NB, passed away on Feb. 17, 2018, after a long journey with cancer. In December 2016, she was given 3 months to a year to live. Despite this devastating news, "Becca" had but one wish, for people to perform random acts of kindness and then to post them using the hashtag #BeccaToldMeTo . She believed that acts of kindness do not have to be big or expensive - they just need to come from the heart. People in over 94 countries have been inspired by this small request! The Legislative Assembly of New Brunswick has therefore declared the third Saturday in September of each year the Becca Schofield Day in recognition of the outstanding efforts of this young woman to encourage goodwill and kindness. In honour of Becca, to keep her wish alive, and to lead up to the second annual Becca Schofield Day (Saturday, Sept. 15), the virtue of the week is KINDNESS.

- It is being thoughtful about people's needs.
- Kindness is showing love and compassion to someone who is sad or needs your help.
- Kindness is treating yourself and others gently.
- It is caring about the earth and all living things.
