#### 1. Welcome

### 2. Approval of agenda

### 3. Approval of minutes from February 22, 2021

#### 4. Reports

**Student representative update** – SRC held a fundraiser for St. Patrick's Day where students bought a gold coin and sent to a friend. SRC has organized a March Madness bracket event that is finishing this week. SRC is also planning a Welcome back event for when all students come back on April 12/21. Another new initiative is "EcoSchools" that is a branch of the SRC that is focused on environmental issues including World Water Day. Plan is to make this a separate club in the next school year.

**DEC update** – Laura O'Brien provided the following update from the recent DEC meeting.

- Ventilation there are 24 schools in ASD-W that do not have full ventilation systems. Efforts
  are underway to make improvements and in the meantime air circulation strategies are
  being communicated and utilized. FHS is not one of the schools affected by this.
- Last week we received the fourth quarterly report on the budget; it is a balanced budget
- The District Improvement Plan for this upcoming year will be a one year plan again, with one of the priorities being social-emotional health and wellbeing
- There will be working sessions in April and May to finalize and approve a capital projects
  list for the upcoming year. 140 projects have been identified by District staff the list is
  currently under embargo but any items pertaining to FHS will be shared as soon as possible
- May elections are coming up quickly for anyone interested in running for DEC. It is a four
  year term and nomination forms are due by April 8. I will not be running for Council and
  am happy to answer any questions about what is involved in being a member of the DEC.

**Teacher representative update** – A. Rutledge gave an update on some things happening at school:

1. Dwight Dunfield: FHS Musical Production for School year 2021-2022 is underway. Auditions begin in May 2021.
