<p>Prom Responsibilities</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Promote Prom to fellow grads, parents, and community members. 2. Collect money for casual Fridays. 3. Help Ms. Hiltz with planning of prom 4. Attend Prom with fellow graduates. 5. Commit to finding grade 10/11s to help decorate if needed. 	<p>School Community Responsibilities</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Support and attend other school group activities. 2. Work with other school groups to create a positive school environment. 3. Encourage fellow graduates to participate and attend school related events. 4. Create a positive grad glass environment. 5.
