

<b><u>In-House Scholarships</u></b>		<b>Students must submit an ACTIVITY RESUME and complete an IN-HOUSE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM (available in Guidance). In addition, certain scholarships require an essay to be submitted. To be eligible, students must be taking a full course load and be writing exams.</b>	
May 28, 2021	\$500 & plaque	<b><u>Ben Collins Memorial Award</u></b>	For a deserving male student athlete in need, (preference given to student who played football) who plans on continuing his education in the fall. <b>Essay required (200 words or less)</b> describing need and/or reasons for deserving the award.
May 28, 2021	\$240	<b><u>Ben and Faye Medjucks Prize</u></b>	For a deserving student with high average who demonstrates <b>financial need.</b>
May 28, 2021	\$200	<b><u>Brian Goodine Memorial</u></b>	For a deserving student who demonstrates leadership and high academic achievement.
May 28, 2021	\$1000	<b><u>Carl Brown Memorial</u></b>	Recognizes achievement in English. <b>Financial need assessed.</b>
May 28, 2021	(2) \$500	<b><u>Colter Family Award</u></b>	Awarded to one male and one female student with above average academics and leadership in extra-curricular activities.
May 28, 2021	\$400	<b><u>Mr. Donald MacKinnon Prize</u></b>	Awarded to a strong Math or Science graduate who has demonstrated ability in athletics or the arts.

May 28, 2021	\$500 (or 2 of \$250)	<b><u>Doris E. Sullivan Scholarship</u></b>	Will be awarded to a deserving student(s) of good academic standing who exemplifies the principles of I.O.D.E – service, volunteering and community-mindedness – pursuing a post secondary program of at least one full year.
May 28, 2021	2 (\$250)	<b><u>FHS Class of 1963</u></b>	Awarded to a deserving graduate not receiving any other award. <b>Financial need</b> must be demonstrated.
May 28, 2021	\$500	<b><u>Frank Greydanus Memorial</u></b>	Student planning to attend NBCC for Electrical, Plumbing, Carpentry or other apprenticeship trade. (Preference will be given to students in electrical trade however other trade courses and/or Co-op at FHS will be considered.)
May 28, 2021	(2) \$900	<b><u>Fredericton Golden Club</u></b>	Awarded to a student attending NBCC, or a recognized business college or trade school. Proof of registration is required. Based on academic performance, student's contribution to school and community activities and <b>financial need</b> .
May 28, 2021	\$500	<b><u>Kin Club of Fredericton</u></b>	Awarded to a civic minded student attending university, community college or a technical institution. Selection is based on community service/involvement. Student must not be receiving any other prize.
May 28, 2021	\$100	<b><u>Maurice David Adilman Trust</u></b>	For a deserving student who has overcome adversity to excel and will be continuing their studies beyond high school.
May 28, 2021	\$1000	<b><u>Mike Fitzgerald Scholarship</u></b>	For a deserving grade 12 student, planning to attend post-secondary. Must demonstrate <b>financial need</b> .

May 28, 2021	\$1000	<b><u>NBCC Scholarship</u></b> <b>(NB Public Colleges Entrance Scholarship)</b>	To a graduate pursuing post-secondary studies at NBCC, CCNB, or NBCCD.
May 28, 2021	\$500	<b><u>NBTA Branch 1826</u></b>	Awarded to a graduating student pursuing post-secondary studies whose parent is a member of Branch 1826.
May 28, 2021	\$450	<b><u>Orange Lodge</u></b>	For a strong student planning to study history at post-secondary.
May 28, 2021	\$2000	<b><u>Robert J. Howard</u></b>	The applicant must demonstrate leadership, integrity, good work ethic, scholastic ability, extracurricular involvement in the community, and involvement in charitable activities. The applicant must also submit a <b>500 word essay</b> explain his/her academic achievements, school and community involvement, education and career plans. <b>Financial need information required.</b>
May 28, 2021	\$1100	<b><u>Tyson Piercy Scholarship</u></b>	Graduate from FHS; planning to attend NBCC, CCNB, or NBCCD.
May 28, 2021	\$250	<b><u>UNB Faculty of Education</u></b>	For the grade 12 Peer Mentor who has shown to be a true model for the students he/she has worked with this year. To be awarded to a student planning to attend UNB Fredericton
May 28, 2021	\$1000	<b><u>The Canadian Federation of University Women, Fredericton, Scholarship</u></b>	Female student going to <b>any</b> post secondary education. Academic achievement and <b>financial need</b> will be considered. Must be a resident of New Brunswick.
May 28, 2021	\$100	<b><u>Xi Eta Chapter of Beta Sigma</u></b>	For a female student who enjoys life, intends to continue her education and who has a kind and friendly spirit.
