# FUNDRAISING SUMMARY

Christmas Bazaar: This was our 49th Annual Bazaar and though we were not able to have all of our fun inperson activities, the fundraising was still a great success! Between the Theme Baskets and the Silent Auction we raised just over \$7,000!

Chapters Night: Another online fundraiser meant missing our lovely choir, but we still raised approximately \$750!

Scott's Nursery -Christmas: This year we offered 5 different products from Scott's Nursery and it we raised even more than last year! Scott's told us we sold the most of any school this year, raising approximately \$2,400!

Spring Raffle: Another successful online fundraiser, we raised over \$2,700!

Acorn Fundraiser: With over 155 items purchased this beautiful spring art fundraiser brought in over \$1,200!

Mabels Labels: This year we've made approximately \$130!



#### **GARDEN CREEK GARDEN CLUB**

This year the H&S loaned the Garden Creek Garden Club \$4000 which has since been paid back. With this money they were able to once again kickstart this successful gardening project at our school. ## **UPCOMING PROJECTS**

#### **BASKETBALL COURT**

This summer while the students are home the basketball court is getting a makeover! It is being repaved and expanded by 8ft making it 31 X 38. The basket ball nets are being reset and it will get some fresh paint! This will cost \$10,580.00 plus HST not including the line painting.

#### **LILY PAD PROJECT**

No more muddy field!

A while in the making, Phase 1 of the Lily Pad Project is finally moving forward! In order for the soccer field to be dry, a drainage system has to be put in. The first step in this project is getting the land surveyed and having an engineering design drawn up. This will be done over the summer and will cost \$4000 + HST.

Stay tuned for more fundraising initiatives in the new school year as completing the drainage system could cost upwards of \$100,000.

#### SCHOOL SPIRIT SPENDING

Every year the H&S spends some of our budget on activities that increase school spirit and show our thanks to teachers & staff!

For the last few years the H&S has given \$100 to each teacher at the beginning of the year for student enrichment supplies.

In February during Teachers Appreciation Week the H&S purchased lunch for every member of staff from Fadi's.

Administrative Assistant Day was April 21st and the H&S bought flowers and gifts for our two wonderful school Administrators - without whom we wouldn't be able to run all our online fundraisers!
