**New Business**

1. Parking Lot Protocol: The congestion on Golf Club Road seems to have been resolved since a memo was sent out to parents, but on the school grounds there are still problems. Parents are still parking on the crosswalk and generally crowding the children by parking outside of authorized spaces. To resolve the congestion, the sign on the old tennis court parking lot will be changed from "Staff Parking" to "Parking" and an email memo will be sent to remind people to park in the lot.

2. A discussion has been started about whether GC should have a better outdoor classroom, since the current one is too small to be usable. Jacquie will ask the teachers at the next staff meeting if anyone is interested in using the outdoors to teach curriculum, noting that outdoor learning is compatible with the GC focus on wellness. Possible follow-ups to consider include finding parent champions, partnering with UNB foresters, fundraisers, and grants.

**Report from Principal:**

1. The fluoride rinse program has begun; the first application was this morning. The only, minor issue to be fixed was that the youngest students need to have the fluoride first so as not to interrupt their schedules.
2. The initial school survey results are in; though Katherine will send out one final call for parents who have not completed it to do so. After looking over the results at home, we will then focus where to go with the information during the next meeting.
