Greener Village is a non-profit, volunteer-based food bank that supports the needs of many families in the greater Fredericton area. It has recently been brought to our attention that they are currently in desperate need of non-perishable food items.

As we near the excitement of the Halloween season we would like to challenge our students and families to support this important community need. The **"TRICK OR TREAT" HALLOWEEN FOOD CHALLENGE** presents a call to all Creeker families to donate non-perishable food items to our local food bank, Greener Village. A goal of **100** items has been established for each grade level and a successful campaign could mean over **600** nonperishable items being donated to families in our community.

The challenge will run from **Tuesday, October 23<sup>rd</sup> – Wednesday, October 31<sup>st</sup>**. In an effort to best target the current needs of Greener Village, grade levels are being asked to collect the food items outlined below for the challenge:

### **KINDERGARTEN**

#### **PASTA & PASTA SAUCE**

- Dried pasta, canned pasta, Kraft Dinner (please no glass containers of pasta sauce)

### **GRADE 1**

#### **CANNED AND DRIED SOUP**

### **GRADE 2**

#### **FOOD CONDIMENTS**

- Ketchup, mustard, mayonnaise, sauces, jarred pickles, salt, pepper, assorted spices

### **GRADE 3**

#### **STOVE TOP STUFFING MIX AND CANNED CRANBERRY SAUCE**

\* Items in high demand during the holiday season.

### **GRADE 4**

#### **CANNED MEATS AND FISH**

- Chicken, ham, turkey, tuna, salmon

### **GRADE 5**

#### **TEA, COFFEE, AND BAKING GOODS**

- Instant and ground coffee (please no K-Cups)  
- Flour, baking powder, baking soda, and sugar
