Creating Friends Through Our Community: Volunteering and Life Skills.

1. Babysitting - certificate upon completion

Students who are 12 or will be turning 12 during this school year will be eligible to take the certified babysitting course. Participants will go through the training to become a qualified babysitter. You will learn about child safety, how to react in unpredictable situations, how to care for and change an infant and all the responsibilities involved when being asked to babysit young children. Participants will be expected to attend all four weeks and write a test at the end of the course. Students who pass the test will receive a certificate qualifying them to babysit and be paid for their services.

2. Good Neighbour

What are employers looking for? Would you make a good employee? 
15. Making Math Life Size
