


Humanities Learning Menu

Instructions: Our last week's theme is **GAMES!** Choose activities from the menu below to complete over the course of the week. You are encouraged to complete at least 1 activity per day, or any number of activities that would bring you to 1 hour of learning. In addition to these activities, you're encouraged to complete choice reading for at least 30 min. **Aim for 5 hours of humanities work each week.**

**French immersion students are encouraged to complete at least 50% of their chosen activities in French.*

Include the equipment needed, the number of players, a list of rules and safety considerations, and a name for your game.
