Challenging:

Fred has chickens and sheep on his farm. Each chicken has two legs and each sheep has four legs. Each chicken has one head and each sheep has one head. He looked out one day and counted 48 animal heads and 134 legs. How many of each animal lives on the farm?

For both questions, show your work. *Hint - a good strategy might be to draw a picture.
