- Your relation to the student (For anyone other than a parent)
- -A day and general time frame that you are able to come.
- -The book you will be bringing or if you would like me to provide one. -Your five clues.

Your child will be SO excited that you participated, but remember to keep it "top secret" until your big day arrives!
