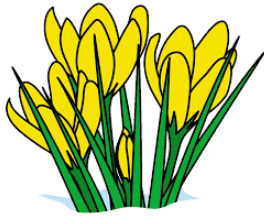


LIVERPOOL STREET SCHOOL

*Teachers will be involved in professional development during the afternoon of April 13th. Regular classes for students will be cancelled for the full day on Friday April 13th.

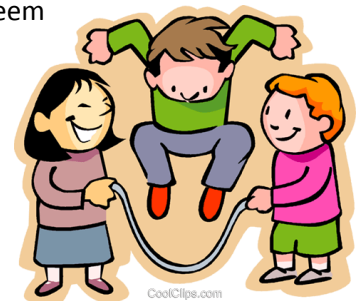
Wonderful Wednesdays

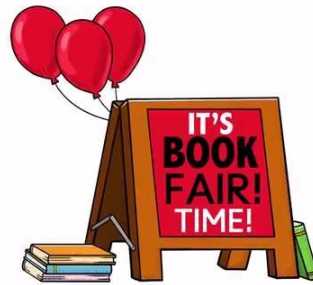
Popcorn Sale

"I'll take the one in the middle."



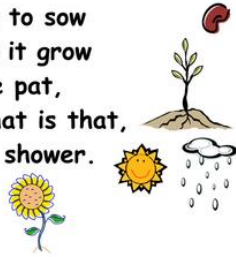
School Closures

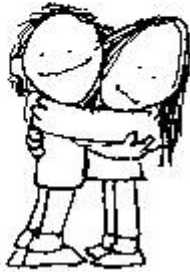
A Little Seed
