Teen Applicant Eligibility

- Commitment to implement community service project
- 15 to 18 years old with at least 4 months of high school or CEGEP remaining before graduation
- Demonstrated interest, & limited experience, in the USA

- Ottawa, Ontario, Canada
- Plattsburgh, New York, USA
- Washington, D.C., USA

Adult Mentor Applicant Eligibility

- Demonstrated commitment to supporting youth
- Willingness to mentor youth during 2019/2020 school year

Dates

July 15 to August 2, 2019

We Especially Encourage Applicants

- Who have not previously visited the USA
- Who are new Canadians
- Who are First Nations, Inuit, or Metis persons
- Who reflect the geographic, ethnic, and socioeconomic diversity of Canada

Costs

- No application fee
- Travel, meal, and lodging costs associated with participation from July 15 to August 2 are covered by the Youth Ambassadors Program.
- Health care benefits with limitations provided in USA
- Participants provide personal spending money
