



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


Nackawic High Demographics

- 1 Guidance Counsellor










With Greater freedoms comes Greater Responsibility...

 - Teachers will assign a steady amount of homework, so develop a regular study routine. Find and create your space!!








Ok so there is good news as well....

Freedoms

Graduation Requirements...

- 18 Credits
 - You don't start accumulating credits until Grade 11.
 - You only take 21 credit courses in high school. Each course is really important to your success. You don't want to miss any opportunities.
- Can I take any courses I want?
 - You have some required courses you must take in Grade 11 and 12; however because this is high school you will have some freedom to choose courses that interest you.
- Passing
 - Pass mark in all your classes in 60%.



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

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Attendance
