## This week in class:

Literacy: We will be taking a short break from our $2^{\text {nd }}$ theme : "Social interaction" being a good friend. We will work on some Halloween themed activities/vocabulary.

Math: numbers to 100 . We will be concentrating on addition and subtraction to 18 in the upcoming weeks. Focusing our attentions on the following strategies (make 10 (friendly numbers), one/two more - one/two less, doubles).

## This week at home:

- Math: Addition facts; our focus will be on adding doubles, one more/one less, two more/two less, make 10. You can practice at home using these strategies and adding numbers up to 18 (and beyond for a challenge).
- Reading : Please read in English or French for 15minutes every night.
** Practicing the weekly sight words counts towards the 15 minutes of reading/day.
