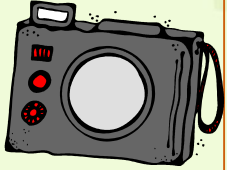
Bonjour, the following is important information for the upcoming week:

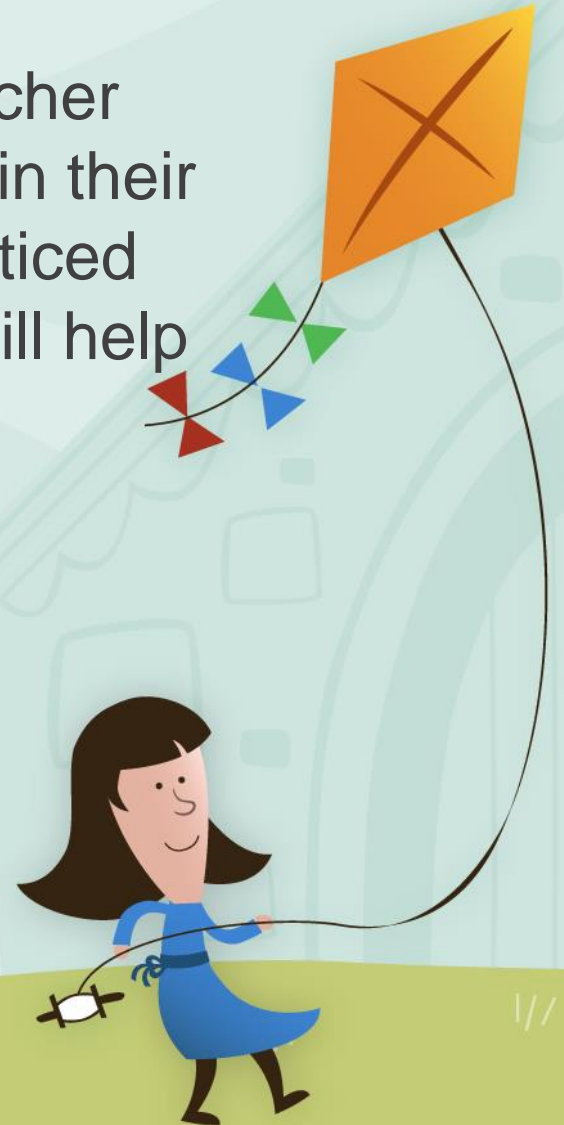
This week's homework:
