## 3-D Objects - 4 in a Row

Roll one die. If you roll 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5 you place a chip on the board for the shape that goes with your number. If you roll a 6, you miss a turn. When you place a chip, tell an attribute about your object. (name, number of faces, edges, vertices, can you roll/stack/slide it?, etc.) If you cannot tell an attribute about the shape—you must remove your chip and miss your turn. The first person to get 4 in a row wins!
