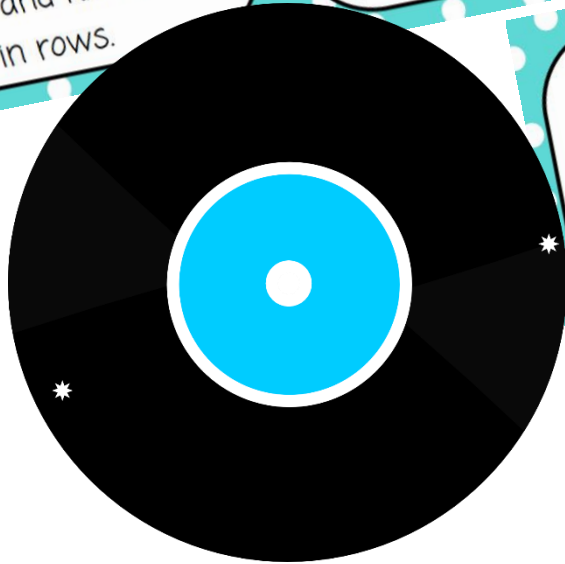
teachers wrote on chalkboards and kids sat at their desks in rows.

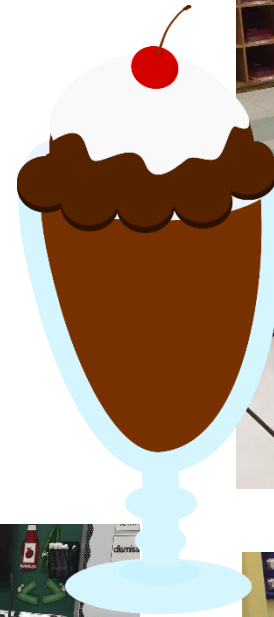


We talked about the number 50, watched a snip-it of a show from the 50's and even danced a couple dances.

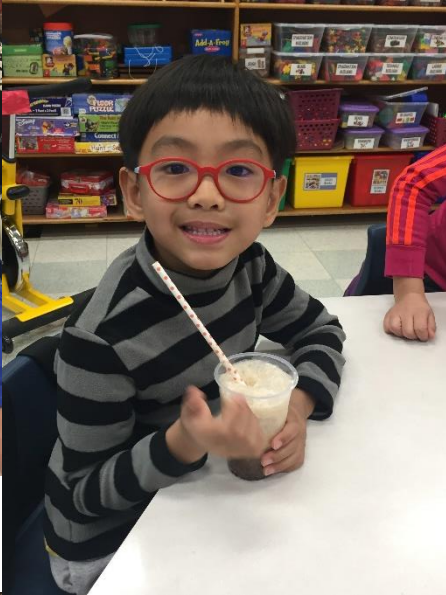

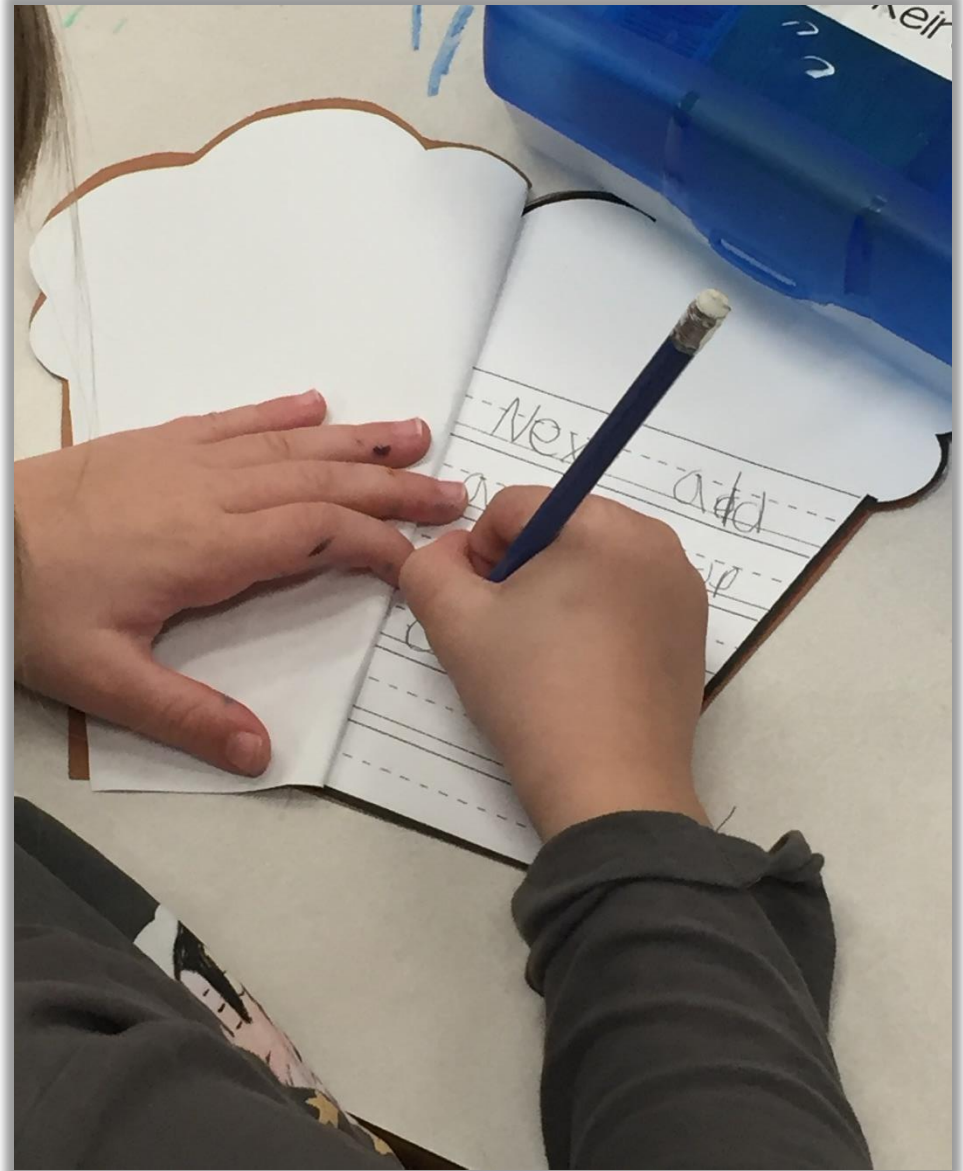
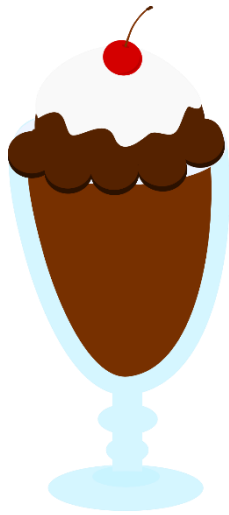
