
What's Up in Grade 2



We will be working on the following curriculum outcomes this month:

Literacy

Reading:

- Comprehension (understanding what we read) We'll learn about "Iggy the Iguana" & making inferences. *We'll continue to use what we've learned so far to answer multiple choice questions on reading comprehension tests.
- Accuracy (reading unknown words correctly) – We'll review all "animal" strategies.
- Fluency (reading smoothly with expression) – We'll review all fluency strategies.
- Expand our Vocabulary (using interesting words) — We'll learn the features of non-fiction (table of contents, headings, diagrams, index, glossary)

Writing:

 We'll write "How-to" books that teach how to do something using steps.

Mental Math:

- Subtracting strategies
- Fact Families

Measurement:

- Compare and order objects by length, height, distance around and mass (weight) using nonstandard units, and make statements of comparison.
- Measure length to the nearest nonstandard unit by: using multiple copies of a unit; using a single copy of a unit.
- Demonstrate that changing the orientation of an object does not alter the measurements of its attributes.
