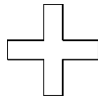

3. Math – Tell someone at home everything you know about the addition sign. You should be using words such as: add, in all, join, and combine.



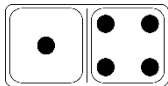

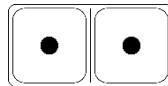
1. RAH RAH – Read your second book.

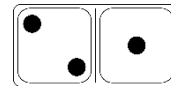
1. Reread a book in your RAH RAH folder. Retell the story to someone at home.
