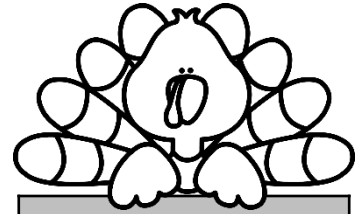

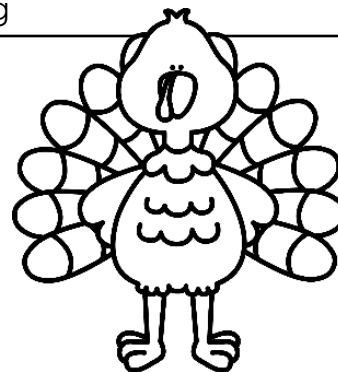
- On the next page practice printing the letter **Uu**.

Dear Parents,

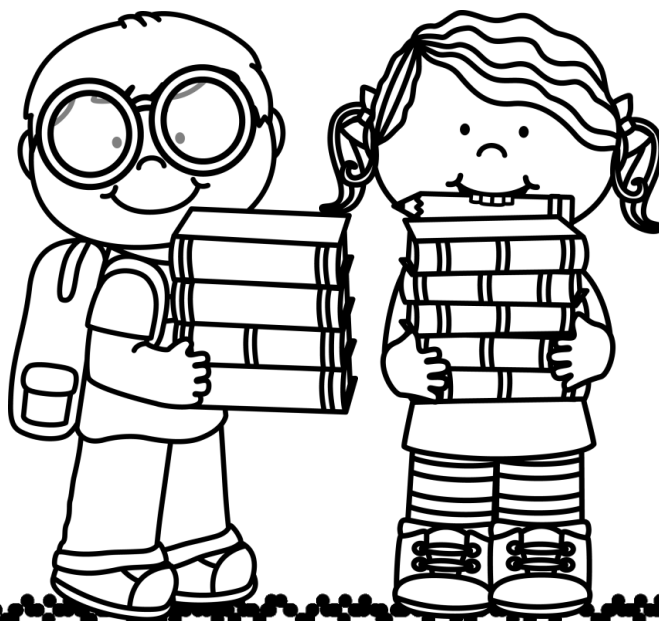
Today we are going to begin our RAH RAH (Read At Home) program.
