## 4. Update from Pat

Thanks for the fence, always someone playing hoops
Did the paving piece - walkway.
The next phase of outside spaces is 3 pieces of paving:

1. Sidewalks leading to the doors - want to make it all asphalt - some students sit by the doors, need to pave it so they won't be sitting on dirt.
2. Lower playground. K-2 basketball court - it's dirt around it. The area that is dirt should be paved. It will be wheelchair accessible. It's an 8 ft walkway. From the cafeteria door to the asphalt bed that's already there and from one corner of the building to the other
3. Where there's dirt on that basketball court, pave that too.

Sewell's gave a quote of \$11,700.00
Other items to consider purchasing:

- Outside water fountains \$600-700
- Industrial, Professional Air Hockey game for middle school - \$1300
- Hang out room/Kid Zone in the hallway
- Picnic tables for shade on lower playground \$500
- 7-8 trees (probably has donors for these)
- Bench and garbage cans out front
- The Townsview Sign could be improved upon
- Kids are asking for a spin bike in their classrooms
- 2 goals for the school. (1) To engage students to be more resilient and (2) student connectiveness.

The kids want clubs.

- Pat will have someone update the clubs page on the Townsview website as it is out of date


## 5. Roundtable/To be discussed next meeting

A suggestion was made to provide a couple of items for the school.

- Ligia motioned we spend \$1300 on an air hockey table. It was seconded by Pam. All members present voted in agreement.
