- 1. **Spin Bikes** Pat Thorne said the bikes could be delivered in the next 2 weeks. They will be put together on site and he will do an in-service with the staff. H&S is waiting to receive an invoice from Pat
- 2. **The sensory tools/fidget toys** will be ordered after we pay for the bikes. (\$400.00 has been budgeted)

3. New items – due to Melissa leaving the new VP will need **signing authority**. Suzanne suggested other members of the committee get signing authority as well. It was agreed that the following members go to the Scotia Bank to add their names as signing authority: Jane Jones (Secretary), Melanie Campbell (Member) and Cherie Linder (Member). • Good info for our next money making endeavors:

- 1. Whoopee pies, rice Krispy treats and fudge were big selling items. **Bake sale** was a hit. The families of Townsview were very generous.
- 2. Christmas movie was well received even though most of our profits were required for licensing fees. Perhaps next year we won't want to reinvest that \$. Perhaps we should offer another movie night after basketball season mid-March. Easter is April 14-17. Could show Finding Dory or Sing. We should ensure the movie is an hour and a half in duration or shorter. The mats offered by Townsview School staff got dirty and wet. Townsview admin staff would prefer not to use the mats next time. Suzanne recommended we shoot for April 6.
- 3. **Candy-o- grams**. Information missing from some tags created extra work for the Townsview Administrative staff. Also, it was noted that some students didn't receive any candy-o-grams therefore Townsview purchased one for every student. Seemed like the middle school kids didn't participate in the event as much as the elementary students and their families did. The committee challenged itself to come up with an improved, all-inclusive method of selling and delivering candy-o-grams next Christmas.
- **Upcoming AGM meeting in Moncton** the home and school federation has an annual meeting. We have to pay for the hotel and very small registration fee. Moncton April 28 and 29. Any interest from members? Suzanne might go. Topics will be posted soon.
- Future fund raisers Middle School dance Jan 26 Jane, Suzanne and Melanie are available. Need to do inventory of pop. Maybe add more pizza. Maybe let Mednuxnekeag Consolidated School know. Should purchase extra Dr. Pepper, Mountain Dew red & root beer. Suzanne has a 40 pack of water at home. Need to buy juice too. Suzanne will pick up the pizza. Krista will order glow sticks.
- **Teacher appreciation week** Perhaps the week of Feb 12 18. We will sponsor: a coffee & muffin day; a candy buffet day, and a cookie day. We need to purchase Kcups (coffee, tea and hot chocolate), flavoured creamer, stir sticks and sugar. Suzanne will ask McDonalds to donate coffee cards to give to the 6 bus drivers.
