We have been working very hard to ensure a safe learning environment for your child and thought you might have some questions. Here are a few questions with answers that you might find beneficial. FAQ - Frequently Asked Questions:

Will my child need to wear their mask all day?

- No. Students will be strongly encouraged to wear their masks in common areas such as hallways, stairs, and washrooms.

Does my child need a clean community mask every day?

- Yes. It is strongly encouraged that students bring two clean community masks every day and a clean container/bag, etc. for storage.

What will happen if a student forgets their mask?

- Hopefully, students will always remember their clean community mask every day. If on occasion, a student forgets their mask, one will be provided.

Will there be a breakfast and lunch program?

- Yes. We have plans to have a complimentary breakfast program and a lunch program that students pay for - they just might look a little bit different this year.
 - The complimentary breakfast program will begin Tuesday, September 8th and the lunch program will begin on Friday, September 11th.

Will staff microwave student lunches?

- No. Due to safety reasons, staff will not be heating student lunches.

Will I be able to walk my child to their classroom the first day of school?

- No. For safety reasons, parents/caregivers are strongly encouraged to communicate via phone and/or email with staff. If a parent/caregiver needs to meet with staff in person, an appointment is required, and safety protocols need to be followed. Families of kindergarten and new students will be contacted before the start of school to set up an appointment to visit.

Will I be able to see the school Operational Plan?

- Yes. The Operational Plan for BrES will be made public and will be posted on the school website on September 3, 2020. This document is subject to change based on Government/district guidelines.

What time will school be open for school drop-off each morning?

- The school will open at 8:00 a.m. each day when supervision begins. For safety reasons, students will not be permitted into the building before supervision begins.

Will students be able to play outside on the playground at recess?
