This is Mrs. McIntosh and it is Thursday, October 1, 2020.

We are updating our information on technology needs as we prepare for online learning should school be closed during the 2020-21 school year. A questionnaire regarding technology needs went home yesterday or today with your child. Could you please return these completed questionnaires back to the school by Monday, October 5th.

"We've Got your Back River Valley" is in the preparation stages to begin another school year of providing backpacks/bags of food for students (who experience food insecurity) to take home from school on the weekends. They have been operational since the fall of 2014, slowly growing and extending their outreach to include all 6 schools in the Carleton North catchment area. All students should have received a form. Please return a form, for every backpack you wish to receive, by Monday, October 5th.

These messages are reminders:

This is a message for all parents or guardians of grade 7 students. Public Health nurses will be coming to our school tomorrow to offer the grade 7 students' vaccines. We encourage you to make sure your child has had breakfast and snacks available for after the immunizations. Please ask that your child wear a short-sleeved shirt. All students are eligible to receive a vaccine against Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (whooping cough), and a vaccine against Human Papillomavirus (HPV). Your child should have received two information pamphlets at the beginning of the school year.

If the consent form has not been returned to your child's teacher, please do so before the school clinic date. These consents should be returned whether the student is being immunized or not.
