Anglophone West School District has sent out a revised school calendar. On Friday, October 30, 2020 there will be no school for students due to a Professional Learning Day for Staff.

There will be a Home and School meeting on Tuesday, October 20th, at 6:30 p.m. at the Western Valley Multiplex. They are looking for new members if anyone would like to come and join.

Kindergarten Registration will take place at CCS between October 13-23, 2020 for children who will turn five by December 31, 2021 and who start school in September 2021. Due to COVID 19 restrictions, parents are encouraged to register their child for kindergarten online. Go to <http://web1.nbed.nb.ca/sites/ASD-W.Pages/default.aspx> . Go under parents and click on Kindergarten. Online registration will be available starting October 13, 2020. Once you have completed the online registration form, we will contact you for a follow-up scheduled appointment to complete your child's registration. If you are unable to register your child for kindergarten online, please reach out to our school at 276-4000 to schedule an appointment to register your child.

Also when possible only 1 person to register your child at the school. Wearing a mask is mandatory. Please follow all school safety requirements. Please bring photocopies or scanned copies of your child's birth certificate, medicare and immunization documents (if possible); if not, we will copy for you.

Please note that all immunizations must be in order prior to starting school in September 2021.

If you know of a child that will be starting Kindergarten in September of 2021 that do not have siblings in this school, please pass this information on.

Be sure to register your child between October 13-23, and you will receive information and invitations for activities to support your child's learning. We look forward to welcoming your child to kindergarten!

The Canadian MedicAlert Foundation has created the "No Child Without" program. This program provides students from the age of 4 until their 14th birthday with 24 hour protection of MedicAlert emergency information services at no cost.

Some conditions that emergency responders need to know in an emergency are severe allergies to drugs, food or insects, needs Epipen or Twinject, Asthma, Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), Autism, Epilepsy, Diabetes, Hemophilia, Visual or Hearing Impairment, and Devices or Implants.

Having MedicAlert identification can alert school staff, friends, coaches and others about your child's medical condition or special needs when it matters most.
