The following messages are reminders:

Registration for Kindergarten for the 2017-2018 School Year will take place at your local school from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. starting next Tuesday, October 11 to Friday, October 14, 2016. This is for children who reach the age of five years on or before September 1, 2017. Children who reach the age of five years between September 2nd and December 31st, 2017, inclusive, are eligible to begin Kindergarten in September 2017, but attendance is not compulsory. Parents of these children may defer the entry into Kindergarten of these children until September 2018.

Requirements for registration are Proof of Age in the form of a Birth Certificate, Passport, or Immigration Papers, Medicare Number and Proof of Immunization.

If you know of any children starting Kindergarten that do not have siblings in this school, can you please pass this message on.
