All students are eligible to receive a vaccine against Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (whooping cough), and a vaccine against Human Papillomavirus (HPV). Your child should have received two information pamphlets.

Please complete the consent form, and return it to your child's teacher. A signature is required for each vaccine on this form. This should be returned whether the student is being immunized or not.

Having MedicAlert identification can alert school staff, friends, coaches and others about your child’s medical condition or special needs when it matters most.
