Some conditions that emergency responders need to know in an emergency are severe allergies to drugs, food or insects, needs EpiPen or Twinject, Asthma, Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), Autism, Epilepsy, Diabetes, Hemophilia, Visual or Hearing impairment, and Devices or implants.

Having MedicAlert identification can alert school staff, friends, coaches and others about your child’s medical condition or special needs when it matters most.
