This is a message for all parents or guardians of grade 7 students. Public Health nurses will be coming to our school on September 21, 2018 to offer the grade 7 students vaccines. All students are eligible to receive a vaccine against Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (whooping cough), and a vaccine against Human Papillomavirus (HPV). Your child should have received two information pamphlets at the beginning of the school year.

If the consent form has not been returned to your child's teacher please do so before the school clinic date. These consents should be returned whether the student is being immunized or not.

The Canadian MedicAlert Foundation has created the “No Child Without” program. This program provides students from the age of 4 until their 14th birthday with 24 hour protection of MedicAlert emergency information services, at no cost.

Some conditions that emergency responders need to know in an emergency are severe allergies to drugs, food or insects, needs EpiPen or Twinject, Asthma, Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), Autism, Epilepsy, Diabetes, Hemophilia, Visual or Hearing impairment, and Devices or implants.

Having MedicAlert identification can alert school staff, friends, coaches and others about your child’s medical condition or special needs when it matters most.
