

Good Evening,  
This is Mrs. McIntosh and it is Friday, September 25, 2020.

This is a message for all parents or guardians of grade 7 students. Public Health nurses will be coming to our school next Friday, **October 2, 2020** to offer the grade 7 students' vaccines. We encourage you to make sure your child has had breakfast and snacks available for after the immunizations. Please ask that your child wear a short-sleeved shirt. All students are eligible to receive a vaccine against Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (whooping cough), and a vaccine against Human Papillomavirus (HPV). Your child should have received two information pamphlets at the beginning of the school year.

If the consent form has not been returned to your child's teacher, please do so before the school clinic date. These consents should be returned whether the student is being immunized or not.

The following messages are reminders:

This message is for parents/guardians of Middle School Students. Mr. Robinson will be taking his Phys. Ed. Classes outside quite frequently for walks about town. Please ensure that your child comes dressed for the weather.

The Kindergarten to Grade Five Student Fee for the 2020-2021 school year is \$30.00/student up to a maximum of \$80.00 per family. Student fees are used for student locks, agendas, cultural performances, field trips and special activities. Any left over funds may be used for other educational purposes. The Gr. 6-8 student fee is \$45.00/student up to a maximum of \$80.00/family which is used for student locks, agendas, cultural performances, field trips and special activities and also includes a tech fee covering consumables used in Tech class. Any left over funds may be used for other educational purposes. You can pay your child's student fees through School Cash Online. This is the District's preferred method of payment for student fees or any activity fees that may occur throughout the year. Please note that in order to receive the family discount you will have to pay through the office.

If your child started Kindergarten this year and they have had their immunization updated since they registered, please remember to send or bring in an updated immunization for their records. Public Health will be checking these records. Thank you for your attention to this matter!
