This is Mrs. McIntosh and it Thursday, September 26, 2019.

Hot Lunch Menu for tomorrow is Hamburger or Cheeseburger, Wedges, Salad Bar/Fruit and Milk. Cost is \$5.00. Wedges are available every Friday for \$2.50 as well as the Salad Bar for a student price of \$2.50 and a Fresh Fruit Cup for \$1.00.

Tomorrow at 12:40 pm students and staff will be participating in our annual Terry Fox Walk. K-2 students will be walking around the track at the school. Gr. 3-8 students will be walking 2KM down the Gregg Settlement Road and back up the other side. Students should make sure they wear sneakers and bring a water bottle.

This is a message for all parents or guardians of grade 7 students. Public Health nurses will be coming to our school tomorrow morning to offer the grade 7 students vaccines. We encourage you to make sure your child has had breakfast and snacks available for after the immunizations. Please ask that your child wear a short sleeved shirt. All students are eligible to receive a vaccine against Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (whooping cough), and a vaccine against Human Papillomavirus (HPV). Your child should have received two information pamphlets at the beginning of the school year.

If the consent form has not been returned to your child's teacher please do so before the school clinic date. These consents should be returned whether the student is being immunized or not.

Please be advised that flags at all provincial buildings, sites, establishments and schools within the province of New Brunswick are to be lowered to half-mast from sunrise to sunset on Sunday, September 29, 2019, to recognize Police and Peace Officers' National Memorial Day. In keeping with this we will be lowering our flags at sunset on Friday, September 27th until the beginning of the day Monday, September 30th.

Monday, September 30th is Orange Shirt Day. Students are encouraged to join us by wearing orange on Monday as we commemorate residential school survivors and remember the children who did not survive.
