Please be advised that flags at all provincial buildings, sites, establishments and schools within the Province of New Brunswick are to be lowered to half-mast from sunrise to sunset on Sunday, September 8, 2019 to recognize Firefighters' National Memorial Day. To this end we will be lowering our flags at the end of day of Friday, September 6, 2019 and will remain at half-mast until Monday, September 9, 2019 at the beginning of the day.

This message is to inform parents that the Kindergarten to Grade Five Student Fee for the 2019-2020 school year is \$25.00/student up to a maximum of \$75.00 per family. Student fees are used for student locks, agendas, cultural performances, field trips and special activities. Any left over funds may be used for other educational purposes. The Gr. 6-8 student fee is \$40.00/student which is used for student locks, agendas, cultural performances, field trips, and special activities and also includes a tech fee covering consumables used in Tech class. Any left over funds may be used for other educational purposes. You can pay your child's student fees through School Cash Online. This is the District's preferred method of payment for student fees or any activity fees that may occur throughout the year.
