New this year you can pay your child's student fees through School Cash Online. Parents new to the school will receive a brochure explaining School Cash Online and how to register with the other forms going home today.

If you have had your child's immunization updated over the summer, please bring in a copy so we can place the updated copy in your child's school record. The Public Health Nurse checks these at the beginning of the year to check for updated immunizations.
